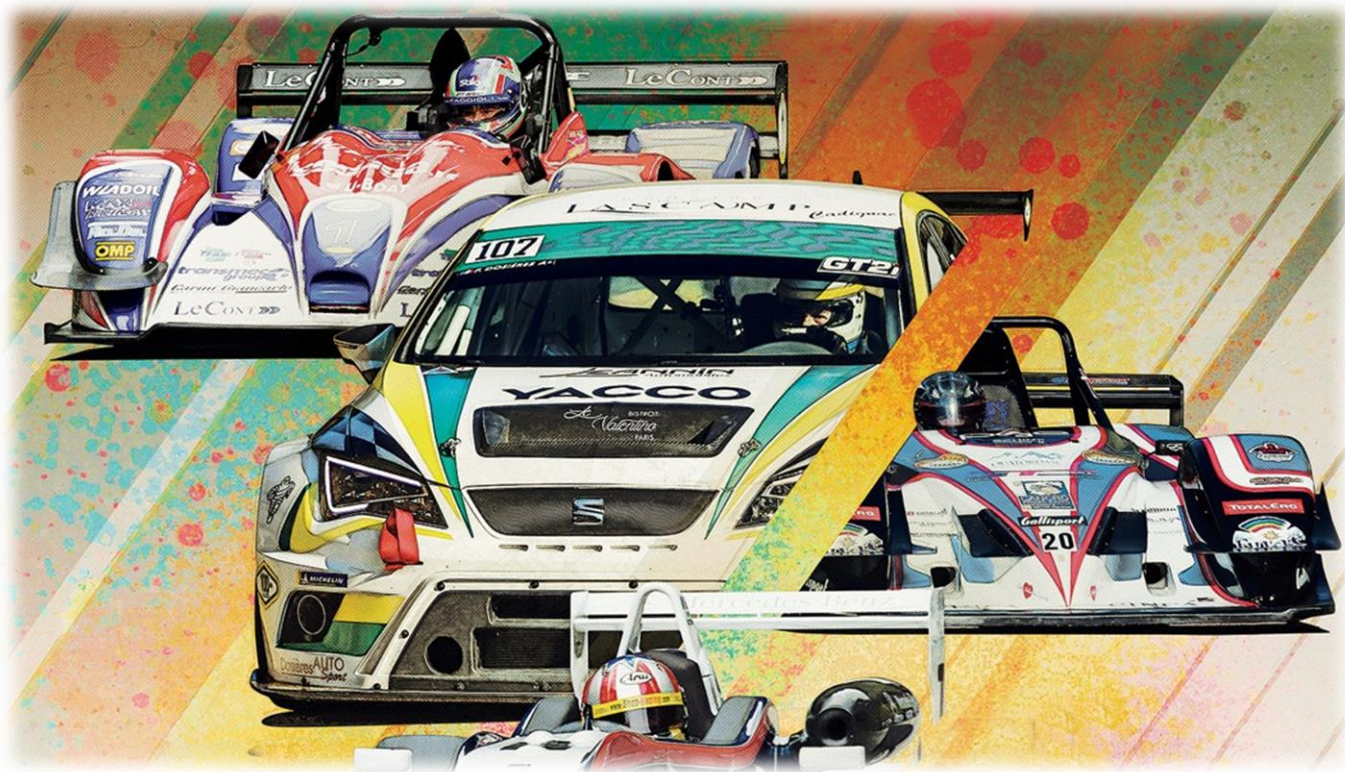

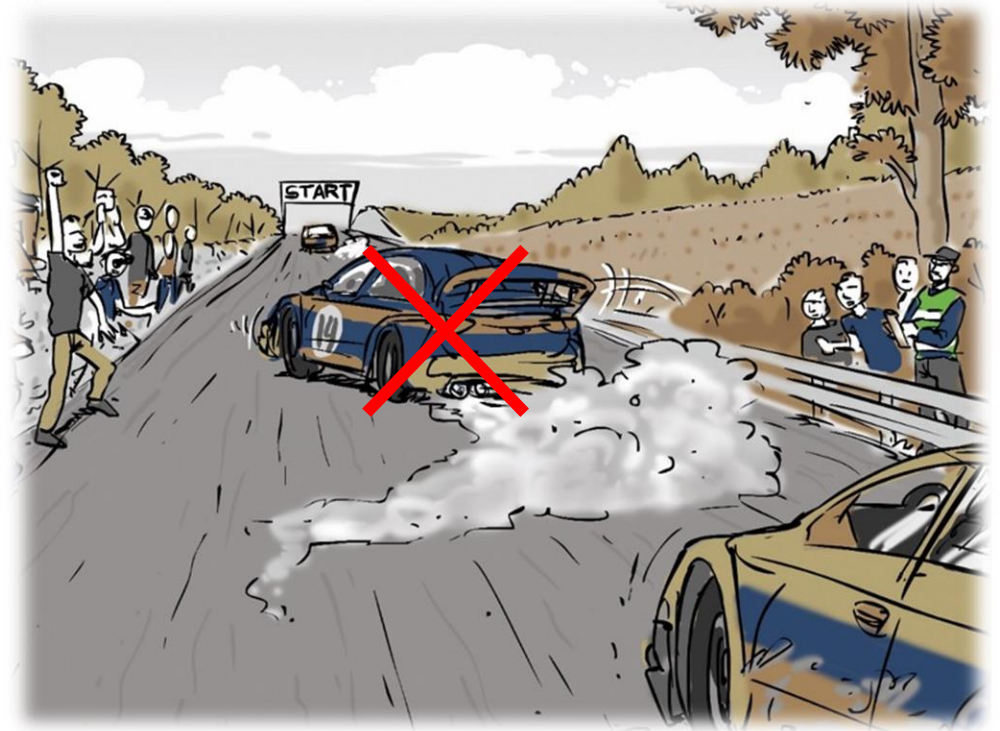

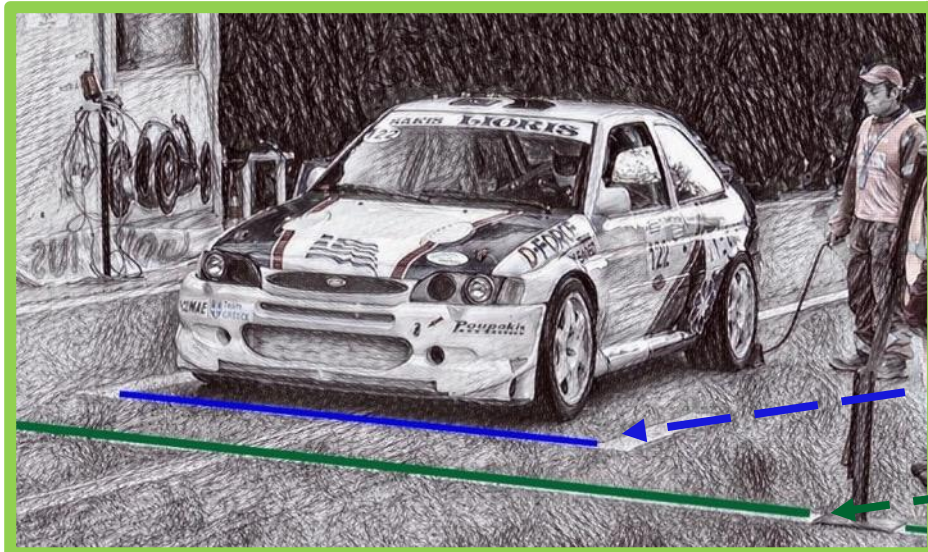






## RESPECT THE POSITION LINE AT THE START

*Start line*

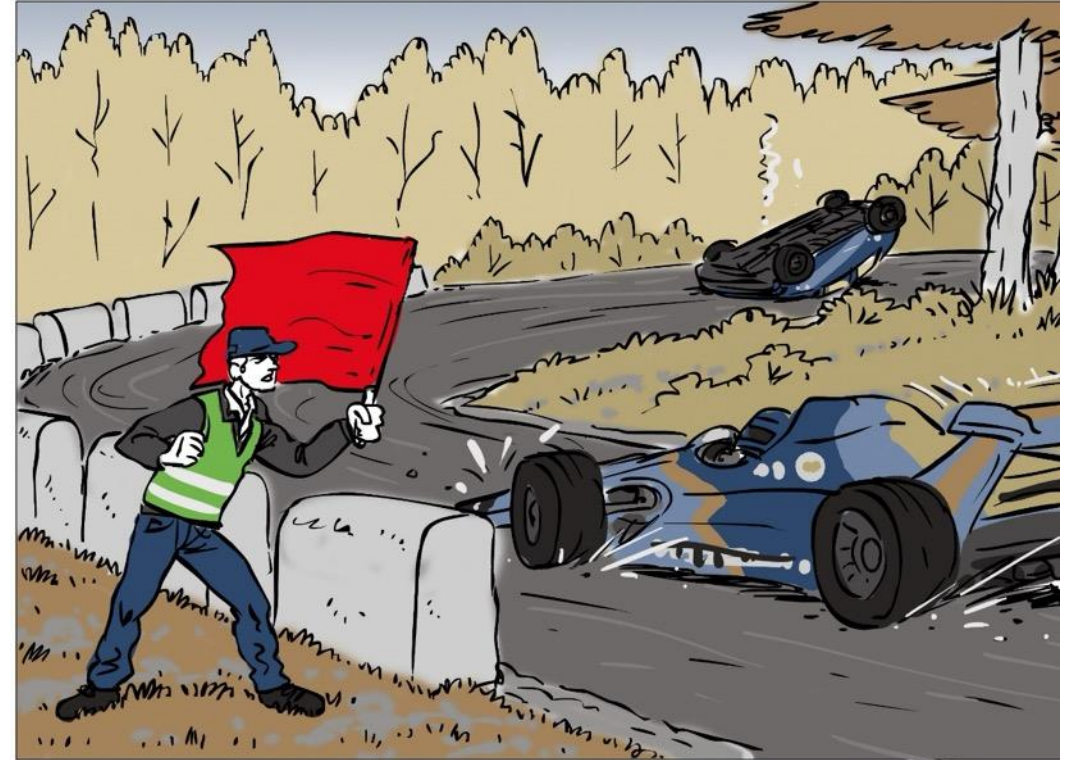


# FLAGS



## RED FLAG

➔ **STOP!**  
immediately and  
definitively.



➔ Follow the instructions indicated by the track marshals.



*Practice or race is  
stopped.*



## 1 YELLOW FLAG waved

 **Reduce your speed and  
be prepared to stop.**



*Serious danger.  
There is a hazard partly or completely blocking the  
track.*



## Yellow flag with red stripes

 **CAUTION!**



Slippery surface, change in grip.



## Blue flag

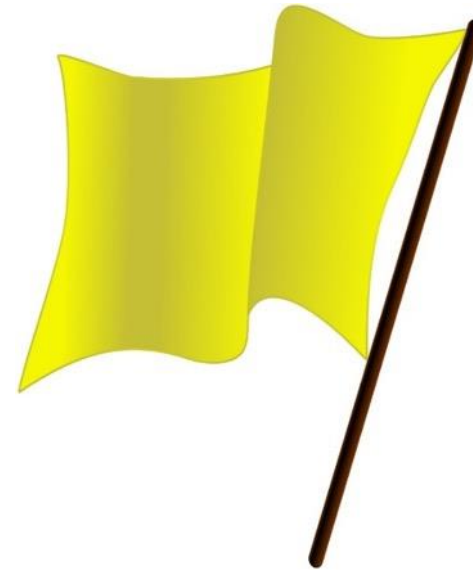


 **CAUTION! A faster car is behind you.**

## Respect the flag signals



**SERIOUS DANGER**  
Reduce your speed.  
Be prepared to stop.





**The flag signals must be strictly observed!**



**Any violation may entail a sanction up to  
DISQUALIFICATION!**

# ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS - CONVOY

- **Convoys**

- The starting area is reached via convoy from St-Jean-du-Gard (approximately 3 km). Competitors are divided into several convoys; **you will receive a document with the timetable**. Please follow the instructions given by the organisers!

Closed cars:          driver must wear a harness

Open cars:            driver must wear a helmet and a harness

- It is paramount to **strictly adhere to the schedule** (*no exceptions, except due to extenuating circumstances at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course*), **the speed limit and traffic rules**.
- It is forbidden to heat tyres, to overtake, or to drive recklessly during the journey.

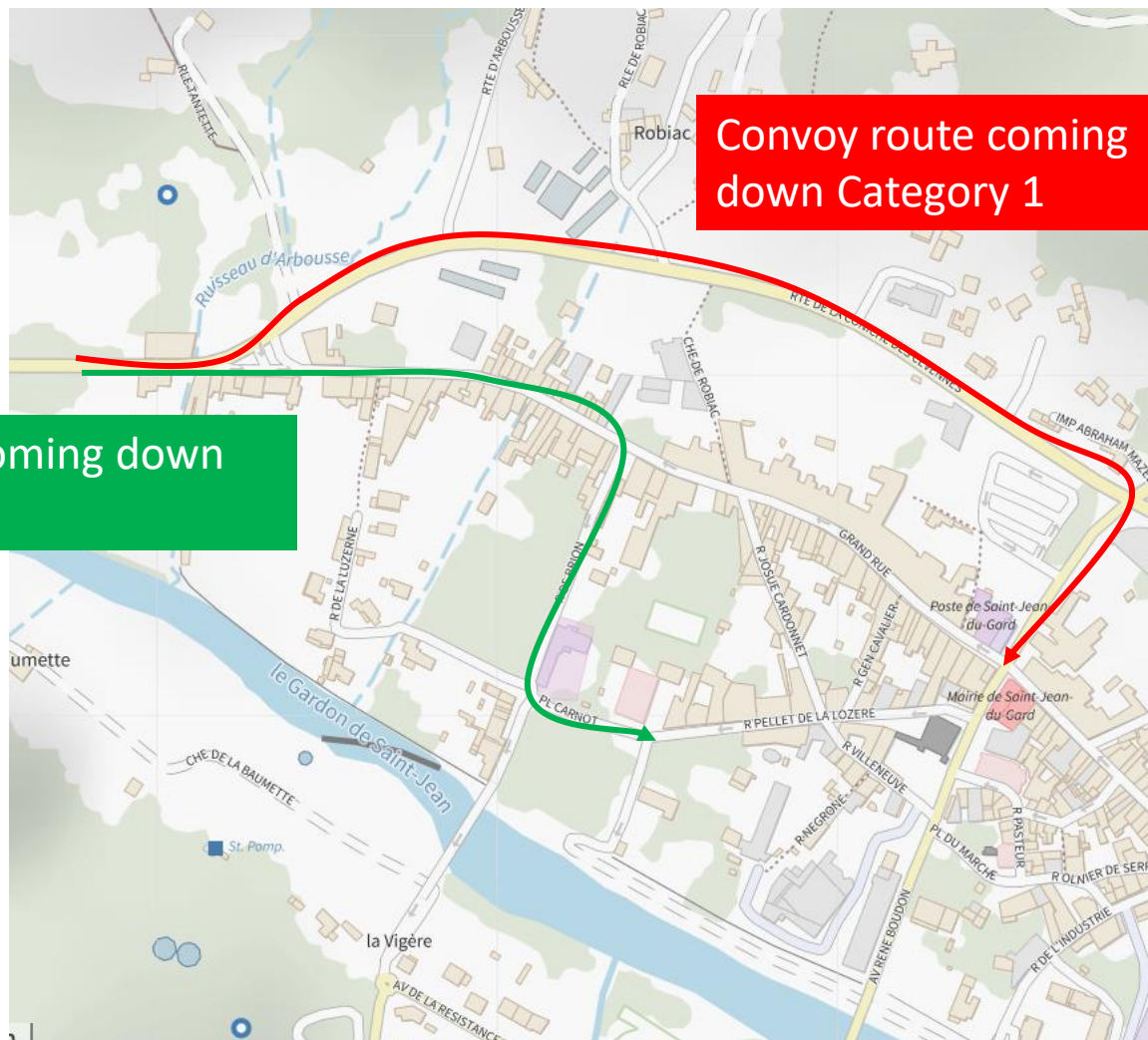

# ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS - MECHANICS

- The **mechanics, who should be clearly identifiable** (either via a badge or bracelet) are allowed everywhere onsite, except the pre-grid, starting area, parking areas intended for controls, timekeeping, rescue services and intervention services, or on the track itself.
- **Shuttle buses for mechanics only** are available in the gathering area for the convoys in St-Jean-du-Gard
- All cars and/or motorcycles **must abide to the road traffic regulations**, in particular in regard to safety (helmet, seatbelt, licence, etc.)
